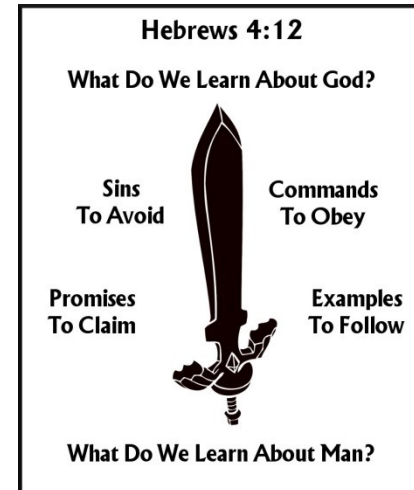
Out – Matt. 28:19-20, Acts 20:20
